1. Representation

The Mediterranean Committee is an auxiliary organ of United World Wrestling and follows the regulations that are applied to the continental councils.

The committee brings together all the Mediterranean federations affiliated to the international federation. The Mediterranean Committee of Associated Wrestling Styles "CMLA" was created and established with the approval and under the guidance of the international federation and in compliance with its statutes and rules.

2. Aims and Principles

CMLA - the Mediterranean Committee of Associated Wrestling Styles is an auxiliary organ of United World Wrestling with the following aims and principles:

- To make the contribution to the promotion as large as possible to the wrestling practice in the Mediterranean basin.
- To realize the necessary and useful contacts between the wrestling federation's of the Mediterranean basin and to strengthen the ties of friendship between everybody, both sportsmen and managers.
- To coordinate the projects of the Mediterranean basin federations aiming to establish meetings and exchanges.
- To set the competition calendar, especially regarding the Mediterranean Championship.
- The Mediterranean Championship aims at: raising the popularity of wrestling in all styles in the Mediterranean basin by the system of an attractive competition, signing up similar competitions of other sports to the habitual practice; attracting the public and the media to an exciting competition; allowing every national team to negotiate with the institutional and private partners.
- To draw up the agenda of the Mediterranean conference which will be held every year.
- The wrestling federation's association of the Mediterranean Basin countries forbids itself and declares itself against any discussion or discrimination of political, racial or religious character.

5. Activity Plan

This plan summons the main activities and development lines established by the CMLA - Mediterranean Committee of Associated Wrestling Styles.

5.1. Bureau Meetings

The Bureau held's two ordinary meetings every year, the first in January and the second just before the Senior Mediterranean Championships and one extraordinary meeting, if needed, during the Senior World Championships.

5.2. General Assembly

The General Assembly convenes annually during the Senior Mediterranean Championships. In 2015 the General Assembly will meet the 17th of April in Madrid (ESP).



5.3. Mediterranean Championship

In 2015 the Mediterranean Championships will be organized in Madrid (ESP) by the Wrestling Federation of Spain, for Cadets and Seniors in all the three Olympic styles, on the 18th and 19th of April.

As a development and support measure, CMLA will support the board and lodging for two athletes from the following countries, considering the countries will participate also with a coach and they must take charge of the travel costs:

- Lebanon;
- Montenegro;
- Palestine
- Syrie.

5.4. Referees Clinic

CMLA will organize a Referees Clinic to promote the development of its referees before the Mediterranean Championships between the 13th and the 17th of April. CMLA will support the board and lodging expenses for a Referee or a Coach per country for 4 days, considering the country and the person participate also at the championships.

5.5. Coaches Clinic

CMLA will organize a Coaches Clinic to promote the development of its coaches before the Mediterranean Championships between the 13th and the 17th of April. CMLA will support the board and lodging expenses for a Coach or a Referee per country for 4 days, considering the country and the person participate also at the championships.

5.6. Training Camp

CMLA and FELOyDA will organize a training camp for wrestlers before (13-16/04/2015) and after (20-24/04/2015) the Mediterranean Championships. This camp aims to improve and promote the



development of the sportive, cultural and social exchanges between the wrestlers from the Mediterranean basin.

5.7. Women & Sport Commission Plan

Following the election and inclusion of Ms. Teresa Mendez Mayo as Bureau member of CMLA and under her guidance and the support of the Women & Sport Commission as well as the rest of the Bureau members, a Promotion Plan for Women and Wrestling will be presented during April 2015.

5.8. Business Club

The establishment of the toolbox (rules, functioning and logo) will be fulfilled up to the second Bureau meeting in April. The first members of the club will be invited right after the validation of the toolbox. Assistance of the National Federations (NF's) will be requested and promoted.

5.9. Commissions Meetings

In accordance with the CMLA bureau meeting held in Paris, January 31st, a call to all federations to propose their candidates to the several CMLA Commissions will be issued. The CMLA Bureau will appoint the members according to their abilities for the Commission concerned. The National Federations must be well aware that they will have to bare the travel expenses of their members for at least one meeting per year and that all members must speak either French or English.

The deadline to submit the candidates is set to 16th of March 2015, so the Commissions may meet in April in Madrid during the Mediterranean Championships.
